HOUSE WINE:

Cielo Trebbiano Pinot Grigio, 2018,
Venezie, Italy £21.95

Clean and crisp notes, fresh apple and peaches with a soft fruity finish.

PRODUCER PROFILE:

Monte La Reina are a modern family winery based in the Established in 1908 Cielo is now run by fourth-generation family members. Over the years they have built a solid reputation on quality having grown from a small vineyard holding to a family winery with an international demand.

Long Country Chardonnay 2018, Chile £23.95

Fresh peach and tropical fresh notes, off-dry with a hint of richness

PRODUCER PROFILE:

Santa Carolina was founded in 1922 by Don Lorenzo Reus in Santiago and is one of the oldest wine producers in Chile. Don brought the expertise of how to make wine from the old central region of Mallorca, to the fertile Chilean Central Valley..

Domaine de Mont Auriol Viognier 2018,
France £25.95

Family property for centuries, situated just a few kilometres from the Mediterranean Sea. Due to its location it produces an elegant fruit wine. Good with or without food

PRODUCER PROFILE:

The Domaine de Mont-Auriol was once a Royal estate and has belonged to the Sarret family for thirteen generations. The estate faces south towards the Golfe di Lion.

Castelnau Picpoul de Pinet 2018,
Picpoul de Pinet, France £26.50

Zesty, fragrant Picpoul full of refreshing citrus character.

PRODUCER PROFILE:

Owned by the Lord of Guers as from the 13th century, the Domaine de Castelnau has very ancient origins. Since 1997, the estate belongs to Béatrice and Christophe Muret, who are passionate about wine and their vineyards.

Stoneburn Sauvignon Blanc 2018,
Marlborough New Zealand £28.95

Enticing Marlborough Sauvignon, zesty and tangy with a refreshing finish.

PRODUCER PROFILE:

Jane Hunter has been one of the most influential people in the New Zealand Wine industry. Established in 1978, they were amongst the first and now have worldwide recognition for the quality of their wines.

RED

HOUSE WINE:

Domaine Bosquet Merlot Cabernet 2016,
Côtes de Thongue France £21.95

Vibrant ripe blackberries and dark fruits followed by a smooth soft finish.

PRODUCER PROFILE:

With a respectable 120 hectares of vineyards located next to his ancestral family home, Philippe de Berthier can trace his family history back to 1495 in the local vineyards. Domaine Bosquet enjoys a lovely location on the gentle hills overlooking the Mediterranean Sea.

Domaine de Castelnau Pinot Noir 2017,
Pays D'Oc France £25.95

Delicate red berry fruits, light in style with gentle tannins.

PRODUCER PROFILE:

Owned by the Lord of Guers as from the 13th century, the Domaine de Castelnau has very ancient origins. Since 1997, the estate belongs to Béatrice and Christophe Muret, who are passionate about wine and their vineyards.

Ugarte Cosecha 2016, Rioja Spain £28.95

Aromas of spice and berries give way to delicious flavours of blackberry and blueberry.

PRODUCER PROFILE:

In 1870 Eguren Ugarte family inherited a small parcel of vines in gratitude for looking after the healer Pascio Pangua in his later years. The estate now stands at over 130 hectares of vines and in the late 1980's they built a gravitational fed state of the art winery.

Growers Touch Shiraz 2016,
South Australia £29.95

Dark berry aromas, this wine is beautifully balanced with ripe berry fruits.

PRODUCER PROFILE:

Mino & Co work with selected growers who each represent their own grape variety. The Shiraz is produced by Isodoro Gugliemino sourcing grapes from two of his plots. One is old vines producing low yields and concentration, whilst the other is younger giving freshness and lighter fruit.

Somborne Valley Red 2014,
Hampshire England £29.95

Rich red, full of berry fruits, award winning wine from the owners of Tregarthen's.

PRODUCER PROFILE:

We are rather proud to say this is ours. Somborne Valley Vineyards are situated at Hoplands Estate, occupying the chalk slopes above King's Somborne. We have three vineyards, planted in 2000, 2006 and 2017 respectively, producing a mixture of red and white varieties. This wine is produced from Rondo grapes.

PRODUCER PROFILE:


Established in 1908 Cielo is now run by fourth-generation family members.

Paradise Point Zinfandel Rose is a joint venture between Paul Sapin and several growers throughout California. California wine history dates back to around 1769 when vineyards were originally planted by the Franciscan monks to produce wine and brandy.



SPARKLING

Arcabello Prosecco N.V,
Prosecco Italy £29.95

Refreshingly dry with crisp citrus notes.

PRODUCER PROFILE:

Stefano Girelli (Italian), Philippe Marx (French) and Peter Kosten (Dutch) got together in 2009 to create a new kind of wine company. Having worked together for many years at leading Italian producer Casa Girelli.

Somborne Valley Brut 2013,
Hampshire England £47.95

A stunning alternative to Champagne and produced by Tregarthen's owners.

PRODUCER PROFILE:

In 2013 we made our second Blanc de Blancs in a decade, both award winning wines. These Chardonnay grapes have been harvested from our Garlick Lane Vineyard, where wild garlic also grows. Perfect for a celebration or enjoying with friends.

Somborne Valley 'Blush' Rosé 2014,
Hampshire England £51.95

An exquisite Rosé with a fine mousse and delicate notes on the palate.

PRODUCER PROFILE:

We are rather proud to say this is ours too, made from Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier grapes grown in our Cow Common and Garlick Lane Vineyards.
